We take user privacy seriously and take reasonable efforts to protect it. We have created this Privacy Policy (hereafter "Policy") in order to share with you our information collection and use practices. AS MORE CLEARLY DEFINED HEREIN, WE WILL NEVER KNOWINGLY SELL OR ASSIGN YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION WITHOUT YOUR KNOWLEDGE AND/OR APPROVAL. Please read this Policy carefully before sharing any personally identifiable information described below.

What personally identifiable information does the Company collect and how is it used?

Personal data or personal information means any information about an individual from which that individual can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

When you visit, register or order products or services from us, including on our website we may collect, use, store and transfer certain information about you including:

- Identity data: your name, username or similar identifier and title as well as the results of any checks carried out through a credit reference agency to confirm your identity;
- Contact data: email address, home, billing or business address;
- Financial data; bank account and payment card details;
- **Transaction data**: details about payments to and from you and other details of products and services you have purchased from us.

How is your personal data collected?

- Where we need to comply with a legal obligation.

When the Company sends or posts surveys and requests for your feedback, any responses we receive from users will be used only to evaluate our web site and services and no personally identifiable information from respondents will be shared with any non-employees of Company, except that information provided in the Feedback/Comments areas which you specifically consent can be shared in those circumstances.

To maintain customer service standards and to assist staff training, we may record and monitor incoming calls.

What non-personally identifiable information does the company collect and how is it used?

We may collect, use and share aggregated data such as statistical or demographic data for any purpose. Aggregated data may be derived from your personal data but is not considered personal data in law as this data does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity. For example we may aggregate usage data to calculate the percentage of users accessing a specific website feature.

The Company may use and disclose non-personally identifiable information for any number of reasons, including but not limited to, working with business partners and improving our web site and services.

Disclosure of your information

The information you provide to us may be accessed by or given to third parties who act for us for the purposes set out in this policy or for other purposes approved by you. Those parties process information, fulfil and deliver orders, process credit card payments and provide support services on our behalf. We may also pass aggregate information on the usage of our website to third parties but this will not include information that can be used to identify you.

Where you have consented when providing us with your details, we may also allow other companies to contact you occasionally about products and services which may be of interest to you. Is my information private with company merchants and advertisers?

May I see the information the Company collects about me?
